Time Commitment

We ask that board members serve a minimum of a 2-year term. Members are expected to attend six annual board meetings, an annual retreat, and serve on at least one committee or working group. Members can expect to spend 2-4 hours per month on board-related activities, with opportunities to contribute more time if desired.

Qualifications

Board Members bring a professional or personal expertise that is utilized to build and sustain Birth Roots' organizational and financial health. They arrive with a familiarity in the following lenses: pluralism, feminism, cultural humility, anti-racism, pro-LGBTQ+, intersectionality, and reproductive justice. Prior nonprofit board or work experience a plus!
